

REPORTING CONCERNS AND POTENTIAL VIOLATIONS TO THE WDNR

If you have a concern or witness what you think may be an environmental law violation, be sure to report it to the Wisconsin State Department of Natural Resources and your County Conservationist first.

When you contact the DNR or your County Conservationist you should try to have the following information ready:

- What is it the potential violation (what is it that you are observing)?
- Where did this violation take place (county, township, road/highway)?
- When did this occur or is this an in-progress violation?

The more information you can provide, the easier it will be for DNR staff to follow up on your report in a timely fashion. In order to keep track of information consistently, fill out the attached incident report each time you witness a potential violation.

Be sure to keep a record of your report. If you made a phone call, write down who you talked to, when you talked to them, and what you told them. Ask for written confirmation of your report and written follow up.

The DNR's Violation and Emergency Spill Hotlines provide Wisconsin citizens with the opportunity to <u>confidentially</u> report suspected environmental violations using a toll-free number.

The hotline numbers are in operation 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Trained staff relay reported information to Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources conservation wardens. Anyone who calls the hotline or provides information can remain anonymous.
